## HEALTH HISTORY FORM

Every camper must complete a Health History Form. **Please complete ONLINE** at [www.blbc.com](http://www.blbc.com); Summer Camp page. If you need a paper copy please contact the office at 269-244-5193.

Please bring with you a front and back copy of your health insurance card.

If your child has a **chronic illness/condition** or has a need for special medical care while at camp, please contact the Office at 269-244-5193 **to request a Parent Directives Packet.**

## HEALTH CARE

Should it be necessary for your camper to take medication while at camp:

### **Medications will be stored in the Health Center.**

This includes both prescription and over-the-counter medications.

**All medications** must be in an original pharmacy container with the correct name, date, and instructions. **Do not bring in baggies or other containers** or they cannot be dispensed to your child.

Common over-the-counter medications are available in the Health Center for dispensing should first aid be needed. These medications are noted on the Health History Form, please indicate all meds which may be dispensed to your child.

All Juniors and Explore 67 campers will be checked for lice at check-in. Should a camper be found infected, the camper will be sent home. The camper may return to camp when lice free. Their head will be checked prior to camper returning to any camp activities.

- Important One junk pair of clothes that may get ruined.

CAMPERS MAY BRING cameras, musical instruments, fishing equipment, sporting items, and other special interest equipment. Bair Lake Bible Camp encourages all campers and parents to carefully consider anything brought to camp. Expensive or sentimental items are often best left at home. Lost, misplaced, broken or stolen items sadden us all.

## CHECK IN

Check-in begins Sunday from 3:00-4:30 p.m.

Enter at the 2nd entrance. Transportation of luggage will be available. Greeters will direct you to the Pineview Adventure Center where final camper check in will occur. **ALL campers must be seen by the Health Officer at this time.** Plan on being at Bair Lake for 1.5 to 3 hours.

**Rookie 2 & 4 Check In, Wednesday, 3:30-4:30 p.m.**

## CELL PHONES

For purposes of safety and security, cell phones are requested to be left at home. In situations where parents (guardians) feel the phone is needed for the trip to and from camp, they will be checked in at registration, locked up and stored during the camp session. They will be returned on the final day of camp.

## SPENDING MONEY

Spending money will be deposited with the camp office and a record of campers spending will be kept daily.

We have a lot to offer at the **NEW BAIR'S COVE** from sweet treats, to BLBC clothing and novelties. Hand craft projects are an additional cost, as well as waterfront tubing.

Unspent monies will be returned to campers. Spending money must be paid by cash or check. Sorry, no credit cards. We recommend \$20-\$25.

\*Family Camps, CIT, Teen Classic and Youth Week will have the option of a cash basis.

## REFUND POLICY

Deposit refundable 30 days prior to event, at which time a \$25 processing fee will be charged. After this time deposit is non-refundable.

## PHONE CALLS/VISITS

While Bair Lake Bible Camp acknowledges the family as the most important unit in the growth and development of children, campers are discouraged from making or receiving calls from home except in the case of an emergency. **Visits** are also discouraged due to our structured programs which have campers active and busy. If special circumstances arise, we will work with families to serve the needs of all involved.

## EARLY DEPARTURES

## CHECK OUT PROCESS

**Week long Camps:** Check Out begins at 11:30 am at the Pineview Adventure Center with the closing rally starting at noon.

**Rookies 1 & 3:** Check Outs are Wednesday, starting at **1:15pm**, with closing rally starting at **1:45pm** This will be held in the picnic area.

**At Check Out** persons responsible for picking up camper (as indicated on Health form) **will be required to show photo ID and provide signature.** Camper meds will also be returned at this time. You will be given a release 'ticket' to give to your camper's counselor at the completion of the rally, whereupon your camper will be released to you.

## SATURDAY RALLY 12 NOON

We invite you to experience and hear a small sample of your child's camp experience. Following the rally your child will be released to you. Due to the large number of people, we request you leave all pets at home.
